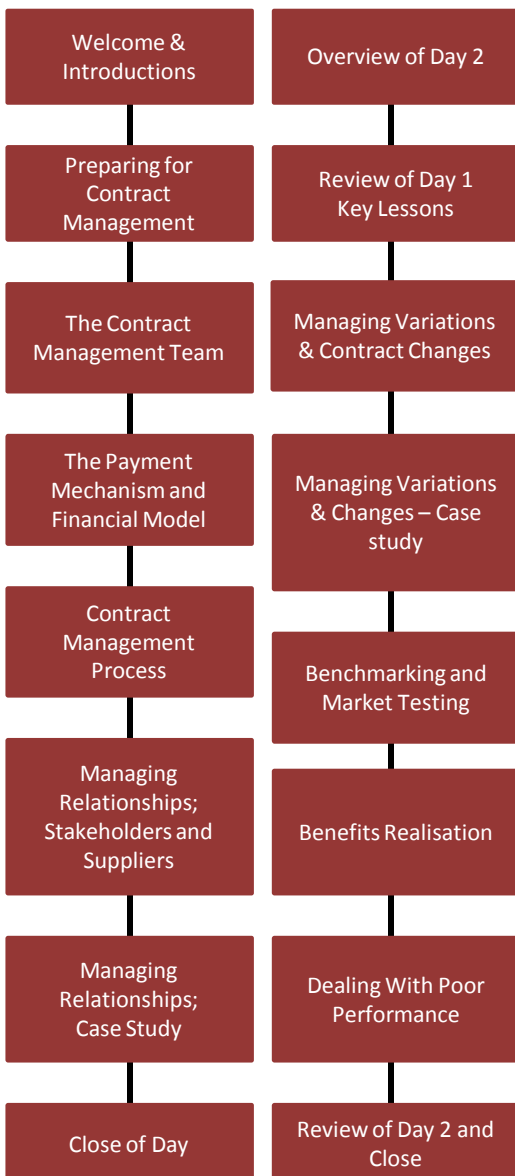




Managing Operational Contracts - Waste Projects

Who is this workshop designed for?

This workshop is for people who wish to understand more about the operational phase of their waste project, or currently have a role managing a (PPP / PFI) waste contract. For all delegates this is an opportunity to have an in-depth look at the key aspects of waste contract management, and be able to discuss key issues such as re-negotiation, contract changes and cost efficiencies.

Why should I attend?

Delegates will become clearer regarding the roles within the contract management team as they explore the areas of their contract which are key to its successful delivery.

Delegates will be able to discuss key aspects of their contract and supplier relationships with the facilitators and other project / contract managers over the two day course relating to their own waste contracts.

They will gain new insight and get a better understanding of issues such as monitoring, contract variations, relationships and benchmarking etc.

Summary of the Workshop

This course is designed to touch upon all of the key aspects of operational management in waste contracts which both new and experienced managers should be aware of, from monitoring to validating the monthly payments.

Looking at areas such as contract variations and value testing, delegates will gain a greater depth of knowledge which they can take back with them to the workplace.
